There are many transportation options from Kahramanmaraş to many points via road, rail and air.








SOCIAL WORK DEPARTMENT

Social Work Profession: Social service, as a term, is defined as activities that should be carried out in order to eliminate or reduce physical, mental and spiritual deficiencies, poverty and inequality arising from the structure and conditions of individuals, groups and communities or occurring outside their control, to solve social problems arising from the changing conditions of society, to develop human resources, to improve and raise living standards, and to facilitate the harmony of individuals with each other and their social environment. These activities are the whole of service programs systematically carried out by the state or voluntary-private organizations in the fields of education, counseling, care, medical and psycho-social rehabilitation befitting human honor and dignity. Work Fields: Graduates of the Department of Social Work receive the title of "social worker". They can be employed in the following institutions and organizations, primarily the Ministry of Family and Social Policies center, Provincial Directorates of Family and Social Policies, and health, special education, youth, social security, and social assistance institutions, in social service areas such as psycho-social counseling services, institutional rehabilitation-rehabilitation services, medical social services, institutional care services, child protection and institutional upbringing services, educational support services within the framework of social pedagogy, family counseling services for pre- and post-marriage, post-disaster rehabilitation practices, etc.:

Ministry of Family and Social Policies, Nurseries and daycare centers, 0-12 age nurseries, Love Houses, 12-18 age girl and boy orphanages, Adolescent Counseling Centers, Protective Family Services, Family Counseling Centers, Elderly Nursing Homes, Disabled Care and Rehabilitation Centers, Special Education Institutions, Spastic Children Center, Community Centers, Social

Aid Units, Ministry of Health, Patient Rights Units, State, University Hospitals and Private Hospitals, Branch and Specialization Hospitals (Oncology, Sanatorium, Pediatrics, Maternity Hospitals, Venereal Diseases, Psychiatry), Mother-Child Health and Family Planning Centers, University Medico-Social Centers, Credit and Dormitories Institution, General Directorate of Youth and Sports Youth Centers, Ministry of Justice, Prisons, Reformatories, Juvenile Courts, Family Courts, Street Children Centers, State Planning Organization, Social Services Departments of Universities and other relevant departments, Prime Ministry Family and Social Research Directorate General, Prime Ministry Women's Status Directorate General, Ministry of Labor and Social Security, Turkish Employment Agency, Social Security Institution, Assistance and Solidarity Foundations, Municipalities, Voluntary Organizations.

Two international organizations representing social work (International Federation of Social Workers (IFSW) and International Association of Schools of Social Work (IASSW)) define social work as follows:

Social work is a universal academic discipline that mediates social change, social cohesion, and the liberation and emancipation of people. Social justice, human rights, shared responsibility and respect for their rights fully replace social work. Social work, offered with theories of social and human sciences and local knowledge, addresses life difficulties and brings people and structures together to increase well-being (IFSW, 2020; IASSW, 2020).

The social worker, who is in the category of the social work profession; is a professional activity that develops initiation techniques for the difficulties they experience in groups, groups, groups and groups, and guides and applies the knowledge and values of service social to the disadvantaged distribution (such as children, disabled people, elderly people, women, disabled people, substance abusers, young people).

The knowledge, skills and values required to fulfill these duties and responsibilities of a commercial activity are taught through many compulsory and elective courses in our department's curriculum. During the first three years, the knowledge, skills and values of social work are taught theoretically. In the last year, you are provided with the theoretical knowledge you have earned and registered in any institution or organization where the social worker can employ. This practical experience that you will have before graduating will support your personal development as well as provide you with professional skills and behaviors, and will undoubtedly make you stronger in the areas you will work.

We are happy to see all data that want to take as their guide many social work values such as empowerment, the uniqueness of the applicant, confidentiality, social justice and freedom, respect for differences, unconditional positive acceptance and working together in the social work department and among us.

ERASMUS

The Erasmus+ Program is a European Union project that encourages cooperation between higher education institutions and the short-term experience of students and academics in different countries and universities within the framework of this cooperation.

As of 2021, our university has a cooperation agreement with a total of 66 universities from 16 European Union member countries within the scope of the Erasmus+ program. Within the scope of our university's Erasmus+ program study and internship mobility, approximately 90 of our students have the opportunity to study abroad every year.

- All associate, undergraduate, graduate and doctoral students studying at Kahramanmaraş Sütçü İmam University can apply.
- In order to apply, students' latest GPA must be at least 2.20/4.00 or 58/100 for associate and undergraduate students, and 2.50/4.00 or 65/100 for master and doctoral students.
- The evaluation criteria and weighted scores to be used in evaluating applications in Erasmus Educational Mobility are as follows:

Academic Success Level: 50%

Language Level: 50%



MEVLANA EXCHANGE PROGRAM

The Mevlana Exchange Program is a program that enables the exchange of students and faculty members between higher education institutions providing education in Turkey and higher education institutions providing education abroad. Students who wish to participate in the exchange program can benefit from the program for a minimum of one to two semesters of education; and faculty members can benefit from the program for a minimum of 1 week to a maximum of 3 months to teach at higher education institutions around the world.

Associate degree, undergraduate, master's degree and doctoral students registered in formal education programs at all higher education institutions in Turkey (higher education institutions that have signed the Mevlana Exchange Program Protocol) can participate in the student exchange within the scope of the Mevlana Exchange Program.

- The general academic grade point average of associate degree and undergraduate students must be at least 2.5 (two and a half) out of 4 (four),
- The general academic grade point average of master's degree and doctoral students must be at least 3 (three) out of 4 (four).
- 50% language score + 50% Grade Point Average.

FARABİ

The Student and Faculty Member Exchange Program among Higher Education Institutions, also known as the "Farabi Exchange Program", is a student and faculty member exchange program among higher education institutions providing associate, undergraduate, graduate and doctoral education within the universities and high technology institutes.

Who can benefit?

Associate degree, undergraduate, graduate and doctoral students studying at higher education institutions providing formal education within the borders of Turkey and all faculty members who are not in the administrative staff can benefit from the Farabi program.

Determinants:

Master's and doctoral students cannot benefit from the Farabi exchange during the preparatory, scientific preparation periods and the first term of the main education.

Each student can benefit from Farabi once, for 1 or 2 semesters. Faculty members can apply for the exchange program as much as they want.

Students' academic degrees must be 2/4 for associate and undergraduate degrees and 2.5/4 and above for master's and doctorate degrees.

Kahramanmaraş Sütçü İmam University Double Major and Minor Programs

- a) **Double major program:** This is a program that allows students who meet the success requirement and other conditions to take courses simultaneously from two diploma programs of the same higher education institution and receive two separate diplomas.
- b) **Minor program:** A program that allows students enrolled in a diploma program to receive a document (minor certificate) that does not replace a diploma, provided that they meet the required conditions, by taking a limited number of courses on a specific subject within the scope of another diploma program within the same higher education institution.
- (1) Students can apply to the second major diploma program at the earliest at the beginning of the third semester of the major diploma program, at the latest at the beginning of the fifth semester for four-year programs, at the beginning of the seventh semester for five-year programs, and at the beginning of the ninth semester for six-year programs, and at the beginning of the second semester for a major associate degree diploma program at the earliest and at the beginning of the third semester at the latest.
- (2) Students who have a GPA of at least 70 out of 100 (2.72 out of 4 on a 4-point system) in their major program at the time of application and are in the top 20% of their success ranking in the relevant class of their major program can apply for a second major program.
